Features:

- Ornamental foliage year round – cream and green variegation
- White iris-like flower with yellow throat markings will spot display throughout the year
- Tight, clump forming habit
- Easy to grow with minimal maintenance
- Frost hardy and dry tolerant once established

Suggested Uses:

- Plant en-masse for dramatic landscape effects
- Superb plant for roadsides, verges, parks and gardens
- Small gardens, patios and courtyards
- Fast results for new gardens
- Striking container displays
- Ideal for filling in narrow spaces along fence lines and paths

Water Requirements:

Very low. D. 'White Tiger' is very dry tolerant and thrives in dry conditions.

Care:

Plant in most soil types that are well draining. Pruning generally not required. Feed in spring with a slow release fertiliser for optimum results.
